

How to Download a Canva File for Printing

1. Navigate to the Download Menu


This can be found by going to File > Download.

2. Setting up your download

To ensure the best possible export, it is recommended to use these settings:

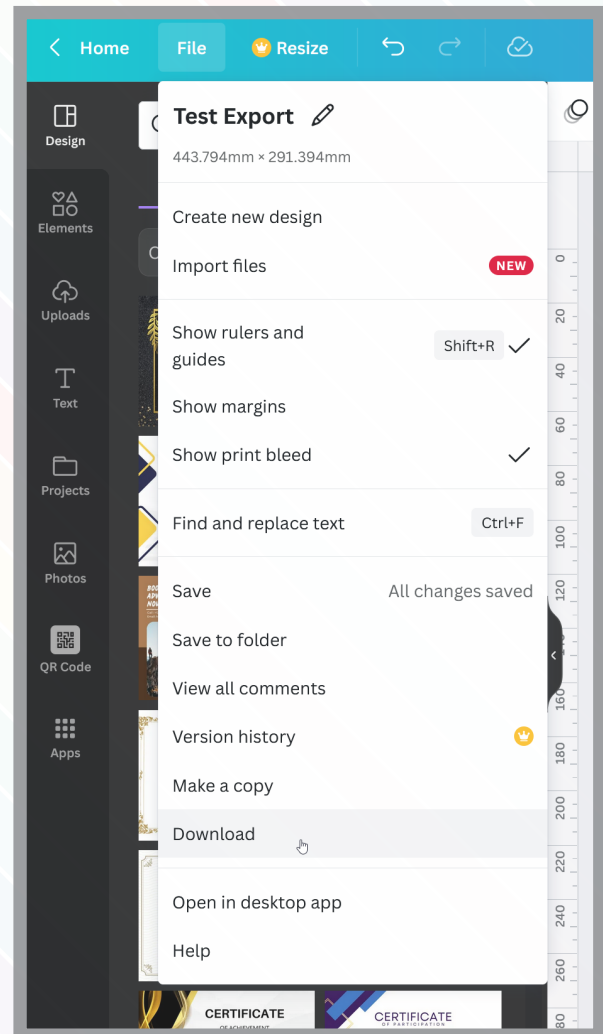
- Select "PDF Print" as your file type
- Enable "Crop marks and bleed"
- If possible, select CMYK as your Color Profile. Selecting

this option is currently only available to premium users, so standard users will have to export using RGB which will cause shifts in color when printing. Because of this, it is recommended to share any color critical components (such as logos) as separate files alongside your Canva download.
